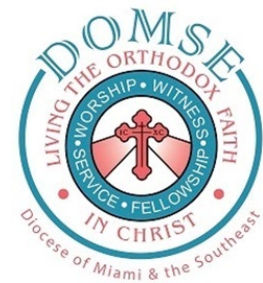

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Applicant must be a current resident of one of the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, or Tennessee.
- Applicant must be a member in good standing, and regularly attend, a DOMSE parish.
- Applicant must have graduated from high school in the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Applicant must be accepted and enrolled as a freshman in the fall 2021 term at a college or university located in one of the states listed above.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The DOMSE Scholarship Committee will review all applications received during the application period of **October 15, 2021, to November 18, 2021**. Applications that are sent by the US Postal Service must be postmarked by **November 18, 2021**.

The award recipient(s) will receive an award of up to \$2,500.00 in annual scholarship funds. The annual award will be divided equally over two semesters (Spring 2022 and Fall 2022), provided that the award recipient is enrolled and attends each such semester. Each semester's award will be disbursed directly to the school prior to the beginning of such semester.

The DOMSE Scholarship will be granted based on the Scholarship Committee's determination of an applicant's merit, and not based upon need. The Scholarship Committee's determination is final and not subject to review.

In making its award decision, the Scholarship Committee will consider each applicant's high school grades, scholarship essay, parish involvement, academic involvement, pastoral recommendation, and other relevant factors.

CHECKLIST

Application Instructions: The Application consists of the attached Form A and Form B, and a copy of the applicant's High School Transcript. Read all of the information in this Checklist carefully.

Application forms must be filled out by hand. Please handwrite clearly. (The Pastor's Evaluation Form may be filled out by him electronically.)

Do not send resumes, photos, or additional letters of recommendation.

Complete Form A and provide all requested additional information. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Print only on one side of the page and use only the pages provided.

Print and deliver Form B (Pastor's Evaluation Form) to your parish priest to fill out and return directly to the email or postal address noted above.

Request a copy of your official high school transcript from your school's guidance counselor or other administrative official.

The Application must include the following materials:

FORM A: This form must include the applicant's signature and the signature(s) of applicant's parent(s).

Student and Parent Information Form

This part of the application identifies the applicant and provides some information about the applicant's parent(s). It also identifies the college the applicant will be attending and his or her anticipated major.

Church and School Activities Form

This part of the application identifies the parish the applicant belongs to as well as any church or school activities the applicant has been involved in or positions of responsibility held over the past four years.

Short Essay

The essay is the applicant's opportunity to tell the Scholarship Committee about his or her faith and how the applicant would communicate his or her teen experience as a Christian to others. The essay must be handwritten and not exceed the space permitted on the form.

FORM B: This form must be printed, the applicant's name filled in, and delivered to the pastor of the applicant's parish to complete.

Pastor's Evaluation Form

This form must be signed and sent separately, directly from the pastor of the applicant's parish. The pastor must be given adequate time to fill out the form and send by the application deadline. (If applicant is the son or daughter of the pastor, have Form B filled out by the applicant's Father Confessor or another Orthodox priest.)

HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Each applicant must have his or her High School send an official, signed, and sealed transcript directly to the DOMSE Scholarship Committee. The transcript should include the applicant's college entrance exam scores (SAT, ACT, CLT, etc.), if applicable.
